A Word from Our Pastor



Pentecost.

The day we celebrate the Holy Spirit coming down and alighting on the disciples like tongues of fire so they could take the gospel out into the world in tongues any and all could understand.

Probably one of the coolest days of the liturgical year.

Definitely my favorite day in the church calendar.

Why?

Because it is a **raucously holy day** in the life of the Church.

It is a day when we get to focus intently and maniacally on the Holy Spirit – something that we don't often do in mainline Protestant churches!

It is a day when we ask God to fervently, unrestrainedly, enthusiastically interrupt our mundane and monotonous day-to-day with the wild abandon of the Holy Spirit and the good news of God's grace given to us through Jesus Christ!

It is a day to boldly and unabashedly wear red ... as much red as possible!

It is a day to be exuberant and joyful and animated in our worship!

That's why, on Pentecost, I always decorate the sanctuary with such an explosion of color and texture. It's about the symbolism of the red and orange and yellow – the life-altering flames of the Holy Spirit. It's about the symbolism of the holy dove – another representation of the Holy Spirit in all Her wild and untamed glory. It's about not just recognizing those ways that God interrupts our lives but *celebrating those interruptions* for what they truly are: glimpses of the Holy, beautiful and fierce and powerful.

And it's also a day to celebrate all of the wild and beautiful things that are happening in the life of the church. It's a day to recognize the different ways that God is showing up all around us. It's a day to listen to the voice of God through one another – the tongues of the Holy Spirit speaking through the experiences of our brothers and sisters in Christ.

This year, I will unfortunately miss celebrating this raucously holy day with you because it falls in the middle of my maternity leave. However, I am so thrilled that you will be led in worship that day by one of our very own: Kamyn Peterson-Rucker. She will be filling the pulpit on Sunday, May 20 – sharing the Word of God with her voice, her experiences, her faith perspective. I cannot tell you how excited I am that all of you will get to experience God speaking through her.

In the book of Acts, in the middle of the story of Pentecost, Luke (who wrote the book of Acts) quotes the prophet Joel:

In the last days, God says, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy. Your young will see visions. Your elders will dream dreams. Even upon my servants, men and women, I will pour out my Spirit in those days, and they will prophesy.

~ Acts 2:17-18

Now whether or not we are living in "the last day" is not for us to know or fine out. But the beauty of Pentecost is that it is a time for us to open our eyes and our ears and our hearts to the voices of those we may not often hear, including and especially the young people in our midst. On this special day, we get to recognize and acknowledge the way that God has poured out the Holy Spirit not just on those whom we expect but on those whom we least expect. We get to hear God speak in all voices, all languages, all accents, all tones and timbres. Because the wildness and beauty of our God cannot be contained in one image – one specific representation. God is all around us. God is in us and through us, behind us and before us and beside us. And that is a wildly beautiful thing.

So let's CELEBRATE!!
