

LET THERE BE PEACE ON EARTH AND LET IT BEGIN WITH ME...



So we sing most Sundays after we have greeted one another with the words, "the Peace of God be with you." This ritual greeting and this song are very important in the life of both congregations, and have been important in our continuing formation as Christians.

For many years, the Prayer of St. Francis has been at the center of my spiritual life:

LORD, make me an instrument of Your Peace where there is hatred, let me sow love where there is injury, pardon where there is doubt, faith where there is despair, hope where there is darkness, light where there is sadness, joy.

O DIVINE MASTER, grant that I may not so much seek to be consoled, as to console to be understood, as to understand to be loved, as to love.

For it is in giving, that we receive it is in pardoning, that we are pardoned and it is in dying, that we are born again to eternal life.

And I believe this prayer is an excellent companion piece to our ritual greeting of peace and our song/prayer that we want peace "to begin with ME."

Thus, June 16, 23 and 30 the Prayer of St. Francis will be the focus of my sermons, as we explore together how this prayer might become an inspiration to each of us and a guide as to how we can become even more faithful and effective peace makers.

Habitat 500 Bike Ride 2013

Parker Quammen is preparing again to participate in the annual Habitat 500 Bike Ride, a 500-mile bicycle ride benefiting Habitat for Humanity and creating homeownership opportunities for low-income families by supporting the construction of simple, decent, affordable homes in partnership with people in need. During this year's Habitat 500, participants will celebrate the 2,100th Habitat home built in Minnesota. Over the past 20 years, the ride has raised over \$5 million for Habitat home construction in Minnesota, the United States, and around the world. The 2012 Ride raised \$390,000! Thanks to generous sponsors, volunteers, and in-kind donors, \$0.97 of each \$1.00 raised through the Habitat 500 supports the mission of Habitat for Humanity. The 21st anniversary Ride, celebrating 2100 homes, runs July 14 – 20 and takes a route that includes the following towns: Becker, Pierz, Aitkin, Grand Rapids, Cromwell, Mora, and Becker.

This is Parker's 7th Habitat 500 Bike Ride (3,000 miles and counting), and he invites and welcomes your support of his ride.
